Dr. Hüseyin Sinan was born in 1971 in Besni, Adıyaman. He completed his primary, secondary and high school education in Istanbul. Afterwards, he entered Gülhane Military Medical Academy, Faculty of Military Medicine in 1990 and graduated as a Medical Lieutenant in 1996.

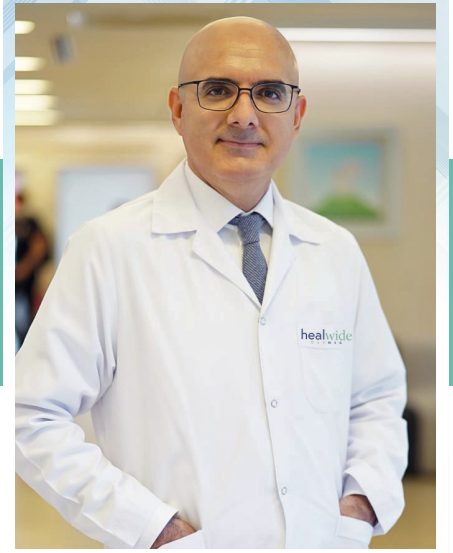
After his compulsory military service in Şırnak, he attended Istanbul GATA Haydarpaşa Training Hospital between 1999-2003 for speciality training in General Surgery. He served as a General Surgery Specialist at Samsun Military Hospital between 2003-2008.

He worked as a Visiting Scholar and Research Fellow for 1 year on "Advance Laparoscopic Surgery" at the Washington University Centre for Videoendoscopic Surgery in Seattle, USA.

After working in Ankara GATA Emergency Medicine Department and General Surgery Department for 2 years, he was assigned to Ankara Mevki Military Hospital where he served for 2 years. After completing his duty here, he was appointed to Van Military Hospital in 2013 and served as chief physician for 2 years. Prof. Dr. Hüseyin Sinan was awarded the title of Associate Professor of General Surgery after being successful in the oral examination held by the Inter-University Board on 17 March 2014.

After working as a faculty member in Ankara GATA General Surgery Department for 2 years, he worked in Metabolic Surgery clinic in Istanbul for more than 2 years as of August 2017 and personally participated in many surgeries. Assoc. Prof. Dr. Hüseyin Sinan was appointed as a professor at T.C. Rumeli University in December 2019.

Prof. Dr. Hüseyin Sinan has many international and domestic publications, book chapter authorship, book translator, many poster and oral presentations presented in domestic and international meetings, invited speakers and session chairs in scientific meetings. He is married with two children and has a good command of English.
